Class Description:

Confident Beginner piecing skills are a prerequisite.

Have you been dreaming of minimally impactful quilts? The Skyway quilt is the perfect pattern for creating modern improv-inspired quilts with a plan!

In this full-day workshop, makers will grow their skills through a plethora of basic block piecing techniques while creating a spectacular project that looks much more difficult than it is!

Here is a list of supplies needed for the workshop:

- 1 copy of the Skyway Quilt Pattern
 - You will need to either print at home or bring your preferred pattern-reading device to access the pattern during class. Printed copies will not be available or supplied.
- Required Fabrics for quilt top: cut, labeled, and ready to sew!
- Sewing Machine
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Rulers
- Basic supply kit: small snips, seam ripper, clips/pins, replacement needles, just in case!
- A thread color that is cohesive with your fabric pull.
- Shared pressing stations: 3-4 students per station
