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WORKSHOP PROJECT



- The Workshop Project is available in Three forms:
- (1) as a PAPER Pattern. You will receive a Full Color Print out of the complete pattern and templates. You are responsible to source your own fabrics and materials. **Price: \$45**
- (2) As a PDF Digital Download. You will need to print the pattern in : Full Color, Single Sided, light weight recycled copy paper, lettesize paper. You must source your own fabrics and materials.
- (3) a Workshop Project KIT: The Kit will include: a Full Color Paper Pattern with all FPP and Applique templates, a Fabric Bundle, paint brush, small bottle of starch, fusible webbing, pencil, Decobob 80wt Thread Spool, Machine Needle and Thread Needle and other goodies. **Price: \$349 Must Order One Month Before Class Starts.**

SEWING MACHINE

- For Foundation Paper Piecing, you just need a solid, straight stitch sewing machine.
- FOOT-An open toe foot is recommended in order to see the sew line clearly.

● Project PATTERN (**Included in Kit**)

● FPP:

- Alphabetizer of choice to organize templates.
 - You can either MAKE your own, or purchase one.
- IRONING:
 - Small iron with automatic shut off.
 - Tailors Clapper
 - Wool Mat
 - Pressing surface
 - Small spray bottle
- CUTTING:
 - A small cutting mat
 - Rotary cutter
 - Fabric scissors
 - Paper scissors
- RULERS:
 - Ideally an "12in ADD a Quarter Ruler" OR
 - (1) straight edge ruler AND (1) 6in Quilting Ruler

● APPLIQUE

- Card Stock 130 weight (10 sheets)(**Included in Kit**)
- Sharpie Permanent Marker
- Heavy Duty Kitchen Aluminum Foil (**Included in Kit**)
- Paint Brush (**Included in Kit**)
- Starch (**Included in Kit**)
- Small Container for Starch (**Included in Kit**)
- (Automatic Shut Off Iron is also needed for Applique)
- Fusible webbing like "steam 2 stitch" or "flexifuse" (**Included in Kit**)
- Washable White School Glue in small bottle (**Included in Kit**)
- Pencil (**Included in Kit**)
- Decobob 80wt Thread (**Included in Kit**)
- Applique Needle of Choice
- Silicone Non Stick Mat (**Included in Kit**)
- Teflon Pressing Sheet (**Included in Kit**)
- Sew-In Ultralight Fusible Interfacing (**Included in Kit**)
- Pinking Shears
- ¼ inch Bias Tape Maker (**Included in Kit**)
- Medium weight fusible interfacing

I recommend making a list of your personal sewing items that make you comfortable and will ensure your sewing experience is as enjoyable as possible, such as fresh needles, fresh rotary blades, extra lighting, extension cords, etc.



○ MISC ITEMS:

- lint Roller
- Wonder clips
- Pins
- Seam Ripper
- Tweezers (My favorite are Swiss Style by Tula Pink)
 - Elmers School Glue stick
 - Pencil
 - IPAD--to see illustrations instead of on paper. (Optional)
 - Small basket for scraps
 - Small Trash Bin
 - White Painters/Artists Tape
 - Light Box or Light Tracing Pad
 - School House Color Pencils
 - Small Portable Design board (Optional)
 - Sticky Notes
 - Recommend: If possible: Making a 30x30 inch (2 inch thick) insulation foam board wrapped in batting and duct taped to the back as a portable design board.
