Class Description:

Confident Beginner piecing skills are a prerequisite.

Have you ever wanted to create a modern improv quilt but were unsure of where to begin? The City Planning Quilt Pattern takes the guesswork and decision-making out of the process to get you the results of a large-scale minimal improv quilt!

In this full-day workshop, you will sew your City Planning Quilt top while receiving tips and tricks for batching the process to speed up the sewing!

Here is a list of supplies needed for the workshop:

- 1 copy of the City Planning Quilt Pattern

 - You will need to either print at home or bring your preferred pattern-reading device to access the pattern during class. Printed copies will not be available or supplied.
- Required Fabrics for quilt top: cut, labeled, and ready to sew!
- Sewing Machine
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Rulers
- Basic supply kit: small snips, seam ripper, clips/pins, replacement needles, just in case!
- A thread color that is cohesive with your fabric pull.
- Shared pressing stations: 3-4 students per station
