## Kaleidoscope Kisses

### Supply List

This supply list is based on a finished quilt top measuring 60" x 60"

This project can be made from a selection of scrap fabrics or a curated palette. When working with scraps there may be more wastage due to the cutting method. You will not need to bring all the fabric to the class as you will likely complete around 9-12 blocks in a day.

The secondary design is created with a selection of light, medium and dark value fabrics. This is easiest with solids or prints that read as solid fabrics but using a tonal indicator or your phone camera on a black & white filter can help select suitable prints.

### MATERIAL

2 yards dark fabric  
2 yards medium to light fabric  
1 yard light fabric

\* NOTE: You will not require all this in class.

You may precut fabric in 4" x 10" strips for packing purposes.

Fussy cutting eg stripes and certain motifs require larger pieces.

### NOTIONS

Fabric Scissors (small)  
Rotary cutter (28mm), mat, ruler (small)  
Fine thread to match fabric colours  
Seam roller/ finger presser  
Washi or painter's tape  
Fine pins  
2B pencil and sharpener  
General sewing supplies  
Template grip tape - optional
