Supplies:

Road to California does not allow participants to bring irons to class. Sewing machines are provided. [Starter Kit Option](#) includes the pattern, templates, EasyPress pen, Elmer's glue, and Finesse glue tips (bundle & save).

- Open toe foot and a 1/4" foot (provided)

Before Class:

1. Order the [Poppy Louise Quilt Pattern](#) and [supplies](#) at [SnapdragonQuilting.com](https://www.SnapdragonQuilting.com) or purchase in class.
2. [Starch](#) fabric before cutting it. Curves require working with bias edges, starching helps reduce distortion and improve accuracy.
3. Refer to the Block BC (Bonus Colorway) Diagram, and cut:

Fabric 1:

- (1) 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" square (fussy cut)
- (2) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares
- (2) 1 1/4" x 8" strips
- (2) 1 1/4" x 6 1/2" strips

Fabric 2:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip
- (2) 1" x 3 3/4" strips
- (2) 1" x 2 3/4" strips

Fabric 3:

- (2) 3 3/4" x 3 3/4" squares

Fabric 4:

- (2) 1 7/8" x 6 1/2" strips
- (2) 1 7/8" x 3 3/4" strips

4. Prepare Templates:

- Cut out template A.
- If not using the [precut templates](#), print or trace templates B and C onto [heavy-duty freezer paper](#) and cut them out.
