Precision Needle Turn Appliqué: Mastering Modern Design with Circles, Text, and Bias with Barbie Mitchell

Requirements list.

Background fabrics:

Charm Squares (or 5" cut squares) - Low Volume for Circle Blocks

For the side & bottom borders - two background fabrics 13 x 54 inches

Contrasting Sashing 1x (3 x 51 inches)

Appliqué Fabrics: Students should raid their scrap bins and bring a variety of fabrics for their appliqué shapes. This is the opportunity to play with colour and pattern, mixing solids, geometrics, and prints. The key is to ensure that appliqué fabrics have a clear and distinct contrast against their background fabrics so their designs really pop. Students should also make sure that some of the fabric pieces are at least 6 inches to allow room for cutting shapes. Note: Bring fabrics for your choices and a little imagination—this is a day for getting started, not finishing the whole quilt, but you'll go home with plenty accomplished. - Medium sized sharp scissors

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- Needles - Milliner / Straw size 10
- At least one 80wt thread that matches your project or a neutral color - Aurifil 80wt thread is Barbie's preferred
- Roxannes Glue Baste It or small Applique Pins
- Silver Gel Pen or Mechanical Pencil (that will show up on Wordplay Fabric)
