Wearable Quilt Patch

Workshop: 6 hours

Description: Transform your quilting skills into fashion with our Wearable Quilt Patch workshop. Learn how to create unique quilted blocks that can be added to clothing, bags, and accessories, blending your love for quilting with wearable art. This session will cover design and application techniques, allowing you to showcase your creativity in a whole new way. Perfect for quilters looking to explore the intersection of quilting and fashion.

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

- How to create a template from your clothing item for a perfect patch fit
- Techniques for quilting to reduce bulk and keep the pop
- How to fold, press, and finish edges for a clean, professional look
- Attaching a quilted patch using fusible web and machine sewing
- Tips for working with different garments: jean jackets, sweaters, totes, and more

SKILL LEVEL & PREREQUISITES

Recommended Level: Intermediate. You should be comfortable with your sewing machine and basic quilting and sewing instructions.

Prerequisite: Students should arrive with a completed, pieced quilt block (a great use for orphan blocks) ready to be quilted. Your block should be at least 1" larger on each side than the area you plan to cover on your clothing item.

- **NOTE:** Once you sign up, you'll receive a link to a video with more on the prerequisites.

SUPPLY LIST

Students Should Bring:

- ☐ **Washed Jean jacket, sweater, sweatshirt, or tote bag** any size or fit you prefer
- ☐ **Pieced Quilt Block** *at least 1" larger on each side than your target surface area*
- ☐ **Fusible Cotton Batting** adhesive on one side, size of your quilt block

- ☐ **Lite Steam-A-Seam 2** double-stick fusible web: one piece the size of your quilt block
- ☐ **Thread** for quilting and sewing
 - Recommend matching thread for final stitches
- ☐ **Sewing Machine** with walking foot or dual feed foot
 - Quilting Needle and 90/14 or 100/16 Needle (for attachment)

Instructor Will Bring:

- ☐ **Lite Steam-A-Seam 2** 1/4" strips x width of block border
- ☐ **Freezer Paper** to create template
- ☐ **Wearable Quilt Patch Workbook:** a PDF reference guide with everything we learn in class and more
