Class Description:

Advanced Beginner-Intermediate piecing skills are a prerequisite. In this full-day workshop, you'll learn tips and strategies to create successful projects and learn the process of piecing with purpose while using intentional fabric choices instead of scraps, commonly reserved for improv quilting.

Get inspired by your fiber selections and let the art of improv quilting lead you to make your one-of-a-kind throw-size quilt.

Here is a list of supplies needed for the workshop:

- Sewing Machine
- Your Complete Fabric Pull:
 - Low volume fabrics: 6-8 fat quarters + 2 yard WOF
 - Focal/Favorite fabrics: 4 fat quarters or WOF cuts
 - Solid fabrics: 4-6 fat quarters or WOF cuts
 - Textural Fabrics (linens/wovens): 4 fat quarters or WOF cuts
- Rotary cutter
- Cutting mat
- Rulers - my most frequently reached for are a 3x18 and 6x24 for squaring up larger piecing. You may wish to bring specialty rulers if you plan to attempt implementing specific elements.
- Basic supply kit: small snips, seam ripper, clips/pins, replacement needles, just in case!
- A thread color that is cohesive with your fabric pull.
- Shared pressing stations: 3-4 students per station
