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ROAD TO CALIFORNIA 2020

Make a “Lone Star” Quilt the easy way—NO DIAMONDS! Using only half-square triangles you can successfully make this traditional, favorite quilt design. Learn several methods of half-square triangle construction.

SUPPLIES:

Sewing Machine, 1/4” foot very helpful

Sewing Thread, gray or beige, 50 wt. cotton recommended

Scissors for cutting thread while sewing

Paper and Pencil—for notes

Stitch Ripper

Rotary cutter

Rotary Cutting mat: Size to cut strips, 18” X 24”

Rotary Cutting rulers: 6” or 6.5” x 24” **AND** 8.5” or 6.5” square **AND** Half Square Triangle Ruler, Creative Grids, or Easy Angle or Essential Triangle Ruler, all work the same

FABRICS: NOTE--This quilt can be twin to queen size, depending on borders.

Star: Fabric 1 (outside points) 1/4 yard

Fabric 2 1/3 yard

Fabric 3 1/2 yard

Fabric 4 5/8 yard

Fabric 5 1/2 yard

Fabric 6 1/3 yard

Fabric 7 (center of star) 1/4 yard

Background 2 yards

Borders and Binding may be selected later or, for Queen Size:

First Border: 1 yard--will be pieced

Second Border: 1 yard--will be pieced

Outside Border: 3 yards--will be lengthwise grain, not pieced

Binding: 1 yard
