What to bring The Allsorts Quilt Road to California 2020

Sewing machine in working order threaded with a good-quality neutral (like charcoal grey) color thread. Seam ripper. Straight Pins. Small pair sharp embroidery scissors. Rotary cutter and mat. Small assortment colored pencils. Camera/phone.

Note that these yardages are to make a queen-size quilt. You are welcome to work smaller in class (make two blocks plus plan your quilt) and bring less fabrics. To make the whole quilt: 1 ½ yd each of two coordinating prints. Large-scale plus a slightly smaller print from the same line often work well but they can be any two prints you like together. See the sample quilt. Think large, bright, crazy, interesting prints. Plus 1/3 yd each of nine different solid colors for the Drunkard's Path blocks. Border: 2 ½ yd a different solid color than the blocks.
