

# Traditional Hawaiian Applique Workshop



In this one day workshop we learn how to cut a Hawaiian block from a  $\frac{1}{4}$  fold pattern, the traditional and modern Hawaiian basting methods, and needle –turn appliqué “the Hawaiian way”. This is a no stress hand appliqué class. It is open to all levels of students from beginning quilters to advanced hand appliqué’ student. The traditional Hawaiian appliqué method is unique in every way.

## Class supply List

- 1 yard Applique Fabric and 1 yard Background Fabric (High contrasting fabrics are best)
- #2 pencil or marker
- Chalk pencil or frixion pen, and a #2 pencil.
- Straight pins.
- Roxanne’s glue baste it small bottle – water soluble.
- Sharp medium fabric size scissors & Paper scissor
- Appliqué thread –to match your appliqué fabric
- Hand appliqué needles (long and thin are best) size 9-11
- Basic sewing supplies (scissor, thimble, needle threader)
