Lollipop Garden Quilt: Flower Block

Easy, Speedy Machine Reverse Appliqué with Appliqué

Teacher: Margaret Brewster Willingham, Eye of the Beholder Quilt Design

Beginner: 3 hours

Join the fun! Be empowered!

Reverse appliqué mixed with appliqué gives a unique, dimensional look to your quilt! Like in a real garden, the receding greenery is created in the background fabric peeking out of the black top fabric. And the blossomdots pop because they are appliquéd. When you do it by machine, it takes no time at all.



Learn the quick and easy steps in Eye of the Beholder's trace, snip, iron and stitch process to machine reverse appliqué, and get pointers on how to satin stitch like a pro. See the dimensional magic of the *Lollipop Flower block* (7" x 7") from *Lollipop Garden Quilt* (40" x 40") revealed as you stitch. We designed our quilt in Black & Bright batiks for Island Batik. Will you make it in black & brights as we did, or re- imagine it in your colors. Learn with others and experience the fun and beauty of reverse appliqué by machine.



Supply List below is to make 1 – 7 ½" x 7 ½" Lollipop Flower Block

Required: Lollipop Garden Quilt XV pattern- \$18.50 print/\$13.88 digital available at www.eobquiltdesign.com.

(If you purchase the digital PDF, print it "actual" size/ "full" size.)

8 ½" x 8 ½" square of batik, background fabric (Green in the picture)

8 ½" x 8 ½" square of batik, top fabric (Black in the picture)

scraps for appliqué accents (blossom-dots)

1-7" x 7" square and 1-3" x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square Soft Fuse (iron-on fusible)*

Terial Magic spray-on stabilizer*, or 8 ½" x 8 ½" wash-away or tear-away fabric

stabilizer

Threads for machine stitching (SAME COLORS as top & appliqué fabrics)

5 safety pins or straight pins for pin basting

Mechanical pencil for tracing pattern onto paper side of fusible 1 pair small, sharp scissors*





PREPARATION BEFORE CLASS: Purchase pattern prior to class. Read the section on Machine Reverse Appliqué with Appliqué on page 6, and do the steps for Trace-1 & 2 (Trace the Lollipop Flower 7" x 7" pattern). Read the section Machine Appliqué on page 7, and do the steps for Trace -1 & 2 (trace the Blossom Dots patterns).

BRING TO CLASS: Lollipop Garden Pattern

- Soft Fuse* pieces already traced with the patterns: 7" x 7" square Lollipop Flower; 3" x 3 ½"rectangle Blossom dots
- 8 ½" x 8 ½" square of top batik
- 8 ½" x 8 ½" square background batik
- 3" x 3 ½" blossom dots batik
- Terial Magic spray-on stabilizer*, or 8 ½" x 8 ½" light-medium wash-away or tear-away stabilizer
- Threads (2) for machine stitching (SAME COLORS as top fabric & blossom dots)
- 1 pair small, sharp scissors*
- Some straight pins

Kai 4" bent-handled sharp tip scissors; Soft Fuse 18" x 3 yards; Terial Magic spray-on stabilizer.
