**Supplies: Small cutting mat, ruler, and rotary cutter.** Sewing Machine Feet: 1/4" piecing foot **Fabric Supplies:** 3/4 yard of six different fabrics (or scraps to equal), Black for Chain: 1 yard.

Pre-Class Cutting Tips for Vintage Charm: (Optional)The fabric yardage is broken down to six colors plus a chain color (black in my sample).In addition to the six fabrics, I suggest adding a few more colors for your blocks—using fat quarters or scraps. Or have a little extra yardage of your six colors.If one color is over-used, you may run out before your quilt is done. It would help you to <a href="mailto:pre-cut 2.5" squares--">pre-cut 2.5"</a> squares-- I'd say 60-70 squares of each color to get you started, and 100 chain squares.
