Wash Away Applique

Students will use a product "Wash away Appliqué for creating finished edge applique in a much easier method. The desin can then be stitched by hand or by machine using an invisible appliqué stitch or buttonhole stitch. Once the appliqué is complete it is quilted and embellished with embroidery stitches and buttons.



Fabrics needed -The fabrics are solid like fabrics. Some of them have a slight tone on tone print.

| Dark Navy Blue Fabric | Appliqué Outer Border Binding | 3/4 yard |

| Medium Blue | Appliqué | 1/8 yard or Fat 8th |
| Medium Green | Background | 1/4 yard or FQ |
| Light Orange | Background flowers | 1/4 yard or FQ |
| Medium Orange | Appliqué | 1/8 yard or Fat 8th |
| Dark Orange | Appliqué Inner Border | 1/8 yard |
| Lavender | Appliqué | 1/8 yard or Fat 8th |
| Golden Yellow | Appliqué | 1/8 yard or Fat 8th |
| Backing | | 7/8 yard |
| Batting | | 24" by 24" |

Other Supplies needed

If doing hand appliqué- Appliqué sewing needles Straw needles size 10 Thread to match fabrics If doing appliqué by machine- Invisible thread Wash Away Appliqué- 4 sheets Fabric Glue Stick Fabric scissors Paper scissors Stiletto or other tool that has a pointed edge to help hold fabric edges down Navy Blue Embroidery Floss Water soluble fabric pen or pencil Light box or window to trace embroidered design 8 aqua buttons 3/8" Sewing machine needed to attach borders once project has been appliquéd. Optional- Perfect Circles
