Building a Visual Vocabulary

Supply list

Basic sewing supplies

Best machine capable of lowered feed dogs, in good working order, and book

Free motion foot. Check with your dealer if you are not familiar.

Walking Foot (regular piecing foot if you don't have one)

New needles size #80 or #75 quilting, embroidery, topstitch, or microtex

Good quality cotton thread, preferably Aurifil, Superior, etc. 50 weight

Medium color thread and bobbin to CONTRAST with your sandwiches

Optional quilter's extension table if you have one

Quilter's gloves, fingertips or non-greasy hand cream (i.e. Neutrogena)

6 quilt sandwiches 15"x15" (or so) muslin (or solid color) top and backing, cotton or wool batting, pinned or spray-basted, NO prints

Marking tools i.e. Frixion pen, blue or purple fine tip marker

Pencil and paper

12" ruler

Grid stencil (optional, I will have some available)

Slider Teflon mat (optional, but encouraged. I will have some available)
