Pat Harrison's Binding 101 and Beyond Supply List – Road to California

- 1. 3 12" x 18' quilted quilt sandwiches (backing, batting, top) <u>or 3</u> purchased quilted placemats with binding or edge finish cut off
- 2. 2 2" strips cut on crosswise grain to equal circumference of "quilt" plus 12"
- 3. 2 2½" strips cut on crosswise grain to equal circumference of "quilt" plus 12"
- 4. $1 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" strip cut on bias grain
- 5. $1 1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36" strip cut on lengthwise grain.
- 6. Sewing machine with a walking foot (built in or attachment), zipper foot
- 7. Sewing supplies the usual suspects, whatever you need to sew comfortably
- 8. Rotary cutting mat, rotary cutter with new blade.
- 9. White chalk mechanical pencil (Bohin[™] is my favorite)
- 10. Mechanical pencil black lead
- 11. Hand sewing needles, sharps for hand sewing, embroidery size as well, a thimble if you use one
- 12. Small bottle of Elmer's™ White School Glue (no substitutes, please)
- 13. Spray starch Heavy duty preferred, regular strength okay too, with cap
- 14. Hot dry iron, hard surface ironing board
- 15. Small 6" ruler with 45-degree angle. Available for purchase in class.
- 16. 6" x 18" ruler
- 17. Susan Cleveland's Piping Hot Binding & Tool™ Available for purchase in class.
