

**Pat Harrison's
Binding 101 and Beyond
Supply List - Road to California**

1. 3 - 12" x 18' quilted quilt sandwiches (backing, batting, top) **or 3** purchased quilted placemats with binding or edge finish cut off
2. 2 - 2" strips cut on crosswise grain to equal circumference of "quilt" plus 12"
3. 2 - 2¼" strips cut on crosswise grain to equal circumference of "quilt" plus 12"
4. 1 - 1½" x 36" strip cut on bias grain
5. 1 - 1½" x 36" strip cut on lengthwise grain.
6. Sewing machine with a walking foot (built in or attachment), zipper foot
7. Sewing supplies - the usual suspects, whatever you need to sew comfortably
8. Rotary cutting mat, rotary cutter with new blade.
9. White chalk mechanical pencil (Bohin™ is my favorite)
10. Mechanical pencil - black lead
11. Hand sewing needles, sharps for hand sewing, embroidery size as well, a thimble if you use one
12. Small bottle of Elmer's™ White School Glue (no substitutes, please)
13. Spray starch - Heavy duty preferred, regular strength okay too, with cap
14. Hot dry iron, hard surface ironing board
15. Small 6" ruler with 45-degree angle. Available for purchase in class.
16. 6" x 18" ruler
17. Susan Cleveland's Piping Hot Binding & Tool™ - Available for purchase in class.
