## Zen Quilting

## **Requirements for the workshop**

**Four pieces of Quilters Muslin** or soft cream or white cotton fabric about 22 inches by 22 inches - fine enough to be able to see a thick black line through it on a light background, but not flimsy.

2 pieces of batting to match

A large reel of good quality black cotton thread

**Several pieces of plain or tone on tone coloured fabric** in colours of your choice, at least 8 inches square. We will not use all of it.

About 25 small safety pins to pin your pieces- mine are about 1 ¼" long.

6 ½ x 12 1/2 inch or a 12 inch square patchwork ruler – the size is not critical

Your usual sewing kit – stitch unpicker, pins, scissors for fabric and thread.

**1 Black Frixion ballpoint pen by Pilot** - I know these can leave a residue that appears in very cold weather but they work well for this class exercise

A small notebook and pen in case you want to record patterns or notes. Your phone or a camera.

**NOTE** Please do not glue the sandwiches – we need the fabrics separate in the workshop. Do not bring glue instead of pins as many people react badly to aerosol sprays in small spaces.
