Fun and easy to make, the Japanese knot bag is one of the most popular bags in Japan. This handy little bag is worn over your wrist and has a lovely round shape. The bag can be created any size and used as a lunch bag, shopping bag, or to carry your sashiko or knitting supplies. To make it truly your own one-of-a-kind bag, you'll be adding an assortment of Japanese fabrics to create a boro patchwork. Finished size approximately 12" x 18".

Materials List – Students:

Scissors for cutting fabric and paper, straight pins, glue stick, small spool of navy colored sewing thread.

Students will receive the pattern for the bag, main bag fabric, bag lining fabric, assorted Japanese fabrics, and thread.
